
WHEN YOU WALK:

Steps to Success

WEEK ONE:

Register online for the Unity Luminary Walk and set up your team page at www.unityhospice.org/luminary-walk.

Set a goal: How many walkers do you want to recruit to your team?

Get people to help: Invite family members, friends and colleagues to join your team and ask them to invite their friends and family!

Ask your employer to match gifts: Many companies have matching gift programs, where they'll match donations to you or your team. Contact your human resources department to see if your company provides this benefit.

WEEK TWO:

Distribute brochures: Place Luminary Walk brochures in high-traffic areas and let co-workers know where they're located. Have walkers contact you directly so you can keep track of your team members.

Hang up flyers: Write your name and contact information on the Luminary Walk flyers and hang them up in visible locations for your co-workers.

Email your team webpage to friends, family, and colleagues to recruit team members and get donations.

Use social media to get the word out to family, friends and colleagues.

WEEK THREE:

Continue reaching out to everyone you know who might be interested in supporting those grieving by using email, phone, bulletin boards, social media and word-of-mouth. On average, it takes three emails to get most people to go online and donate, so don't be shy about reaching out to friends and family more than once to ask for donations.

Get creative with recruitment. Add a link to your team webpage in your email signature, distribute flyers to colleagues in the office, or reach out to friends and family through social media. Make sure you encourage them to bring friends and family members.

WEEK FOUR:

Start a team challenge in your workplace or social group. Encourage employees to create their own Luminary Walk Team and have the teams in your company compete for the largest team and most money raised.

Host your own fundraiser, yard sale or other creative event to raise walk donations.

WEEK FIVE - SEVEN:

Stay in touch with your team members. Set aside a few minutes each week to email or call team members and see how they're doing with fundraising and recruitment.

WEEK EIGHT:

Order t-shirts: Friday, April 12th is the deadline to be guaranteed your t-shirt size by submitting a minimum donation of \$35.

See how you measure up to your original goal for team members. Have you recruited enough walkers? If not, brainstorm with your team about getting more people to join.

Double check that everyone has asked if their employer has a matching gift program.

Review this checklist to make sure that you haven't missed any important tasks.

DAY OF EVENT:

Remind your teammates to bring their donations that haven't been processed online with them on Walk Day.

Have fun! Enjoy the walk and be proud that you helped make a positive impact in the lives of those facing grief in our communities.

POST EVENT:

Thank your teammates with a letter, email or phone call.

Ask for late donations on your fundraising webpage.
