**In Wisconsin, 1 in 13 children will experience the death of a parent or sibling by the age of 18**

*(Jag Institute, 2023).*

Grief, at any age, can negatively impact daily functioning, memory, productivity, and relationships. Children who have experienced a death are at increased risk for disrupted development, poor academic performance, and mental health concerns.

Unity's School Grief Program partners Grief Counselors with school staff and students to provide comprehensive grief education, training, and support following the death of a student, staff member, or family member. Services are customized to meet unique needs.

- Professional Development Workshop - 2 hours, \$500
  - Developmental understanding of grief

  - Learn how children and teens respond to grief
  - Discover ways to extend support

## SUPPORT

- Grief support group for students - 6 weeks, \$1,500
  - Held in school alongside school staff
  - Curriculum and materials provided
- Debriefing following a death - \$100 per hour
  - Individual and group formats for students and staff
  - Materials and resources provided
